Old Business

Estimate for L.Lord to contract with Sandown for Cross Point CUP. \$2,500 to be billed to PREA. Ms. Paris made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Grivas. 5-0-0

New Business

Mr. Knuuttunen asked about the location for the fishing derby since the house is on the renter's market.

Mr. Butler advised, with appreciation, that the fishing derby date and event were made part of the lease agreements thanks to the families insisting!
