17 Call to Order: Chair Donna Martin called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

19 **Rides**

20 Barbara was able to confirm a 40ft Portable Rock Climbing unit: Cost \$200.00 and he will also be able to keep
21 the sales of the tickets for this ride. She will confirm is ticket sale price and get the contract and in writing from
22 company.

23 **Indoor Ascent, Dover NH Chad Murphy**

24 Vendor needs flat asphalt or packed sand area and will need min 10x15, max 20X20 space. It was discussed
25 location would be at the map area of the playground or at the other end of parking lot near the fence area.

26 Karen reminded us the Train ride needs 20' to 30' to safely turn around.

27 So we may need to put Rock Climb opposite from train location.

28 We then discussed and viewed options of inflatable rides from Total Entertainment in Danvers, MA. Barbara
29 will confirm things up with them this week.

30 Both Total Entertainment & Chad Murphy, or their assistants will be present at the fair. This allows their
31 insurance to cover any injuries or mishaps. Both companies have one million dollar coverage.

32 It was then discussed that we will need town organizations to supervise and take tickets for 2 of the inflatable
33 rides and the ticket booth. Volunteers need to be atleast18 years old.

34 **Parade**

35 Karen stated that the Train would happily transport the Selectmen in the parade, (and anyone else).

36 She also mentioned that Arty has an open Hummer for anyone else that may need transportation in the
37 parade.

38 Lisa Chamberlain will be allowing use of her convertible again for this year's Citizen of the Year to ride in the
39 parade.

41 **Entertainment**

42 Rick will connect with Tim and final up the schedule for each stage.

43 Hampstead Dance group will need pavement for their tap routine.

44 Still no Face Painter for the event. We are working on this.

45 Rick will connect with Zorvino's this week. To be sure they will be still hosting the pie-eating contest. We also
46 need to purchase approx 30 pies and obtain prizes for the winners (3 winners).

47 Police have been arranged for the Friday night "Decade Dance" at the Town hall.

49 **OTHER BUSINESS**

50 It was decided that the committee would purchase another cash box with a lock. This will allow 2
51 boxes to be available for use.

52 The committee will not need a table/canopy for itself this year. The committee has no goods or
53 services to sell.

54 Awaiting confirmation from the police explorer's on their Child Find set up this year.

55 Karen will try to firm up the Pancake Breakfast with the graduating TRHS Class. If they are not doing
56 it, it could be opened to another organization in town.
