SANDOWN SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM

Are you interested in becoming a Counselor-in-Training with the Sandown Summer Recreation Program? Interested parties will come to one of two mandatory informational and registration sessions with a parent or guardian on Monday, June 14 at 6:30 PM or Tuesday, June 15th at 4 PM at the Recreation Building located at 25 Pheasant Run Drive to learn about this program that is open to Sandown residents only. Participants must be entering at least Grade 9 in order to participate.

CIT's are participants in the Summer Recreation Program. They pay the regular \$13 program registration fee and are responsible for paying for field trips they attend. Unlike some other programs this CIT Program does not charge a weekly tuition. CIT's may participate for one program week and may be invited to participate for an additional week. Participation is not to be viewed as an offer or implied offer of future employment. CITs and their parent/guardian will receive an evaluation of the participant's performance.

Becoming a CIT is a great way to gain valuable workplace experience and an excellent way to fulfill community service obligations that your school or religious organization may require. Participants are expected to be mature, able to follow instruction, comfortable being active outdoors for long periods of time and enjoy supervising and interacting with children. CITs must exhibit appropriate behavior and language at all times. Attendance with a parent or guardian at one of the informational meetings is **mandatory**.
