

As part of its strategic planning efforts, the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (DES) is placing greater emphasis on conveying the collection, analysis and reporting of environmental information to the public. DES is currently working with the NH Lakes and Rivers Management Advisory Committees to identify what environmental information, particularly in the area of water resources, the public most often wants or needs to know. The survey below will be used to help DES take the first steps to develop tools to provide easier access to environmental information at the state, regional and local levels, including individual watersheds, lakes, ponds, rivers and saltwater areas.
