

NHDES- Drinking Water and Groundwater Bureau
Hampstead Area Water Company, Angle Pond Well #3 Withdrawal Test Update

In accordance with the public notification requirements associated with large groundwater withdrawal applications, NHDES is providing an update to municipalities and community water suppliers within the potential impact area of the Angle Pond well field in Hampstead on the status of the upcoming pumping test. This week NHDES approved a few modifications and additions to the private well monitoring network and now a total of 15 private wells are being monitored during the test. Please see below for the current list of monitoring locations. The anticipated start of pumping for the Angle Pond test is phased over three days next week: Monday 2/25 (well 2 only), Tuesday 2/26 (wells 1 and 2), and Wednesday 2/27 (all three). The pumping portion of the test will run for a full week until the following Wednesday March 6th.
