11. Meeting was opened at 7:04pm by Chair Pamela Gaudreau, after which the Commission Members
12. present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

14. Mrs. Rosenau made a motion to accept the October 2020 Commission Meeting minutes. Motion was
15. seconded by Mrs. Dupouy. So voted by the Commission.

17. **Correspondence:** None.

19. **Events:** Mrs. Gaudreau announced that due to conflicts with a change in the schedule of meetings of
20. the Sandown Conservation Commission, the Sandown Heritage Commission would be meeting the
21. second Thursday of both November and December.

23. Mrs. Rosenau presented the commission with her findings in researching the possibility of re-printing
24. the Sandown History Book "View from Meeting House Hill. Scanning and setting up the pages from
25. an existing copy would cost \$654 for the first ten copies and then \$14.76 for each subsequent hard-
26. cover copy or \$9.77 for each subsequent soft-cover copy. This cost does not include paying for the
27. rights to re-print or the author's residual.
28. - Mrs. Rosenau recommended if this project were to proceed, that a certain number of books be
29. pre-sold to cover costs.

31. Mrs. Gaudreau informed the commission she has been trying to get in touch with prospective Eagle
32. Scout Gabriel Gerhard regarding his project with the Hearse House.
33. - Mrs. Rosenau informed the commission she is working with the Sandown Garden Club in
34. regards to the Eagle Scout Project and that the project is awaiting approval from the local Boy Scout
35. District Counsel.

37. Mrs. Gaudreau informed the commission that she was informed by Commission Member Paul
38. Wentzel that he had spoken with representatives of the local Abenaki organization, who wish to be in
39. contact to help organize events in Sandown.

41. Mrs. Gaudreau informed the commission she was contacted by Tom Elmore, who has access to
42. LIDAR for geological surveys, and will schedule a site walk to assess potential areas of interest for
43. further investigation in Sandown.

45. Mrs. Gaudreau proposed organizing a Sandown Scavenger Hunt in association with local teachers
46. using local items of historical significance which could be counted as credit toward remote learning
47. under the current scholastic situation.

49. **Other Business:** Mrs. Gaudreau is collecting information to compile for the Commission's entry in
50. the Annual Town Report.
51. - The Heritage Commission is in need of additional material to add to the Commission tab on the
52. Sandown Town Website.
