11. Meeting was opened at 7:01pm by Chair Pamela Gaudreau.

13. Mrs. Gaudreau noted Line 12 of the 10 February 2022 Commission Special Meeting Minutes needed
14. to be revised to read: "Meeting was opened at 6:55pm..." vice "Meeting was opened at 7:55pm..."
15. and Line 23 needed to be revised to read: "...meeting was adjourned at 6:59pm." vice "...meeting
16. was adjourned at 7:59pm."

17. Mrs. Rosenau made a motion to accept the 10 February 2022 Commission Special Meeting
18. minutes as amended. Motion was seconded by Mr. Wentzel. So voted by the Commission with one
19. abstention.

20. Mrs. Gaudreau noted Line 87 of the March 2022 Commission Minutes needed to be revised to read:

22. Mrs. Rosenau made a motion to accept the March 2022 Commission Special Meeting minutes as
23. amended. Motion was seconded by Mr. Wentzel. So voted by the Commission with two abstentions.

40. **Trail through Time:** Mr. Wentzel presented four potential kiosk designs as ideas for what can be
41. installed at local heritage sites as the Sandown Trail through Time is established.

42. Mr. Koester proposed using Eagle Scout Projects to create a better walking path for the
43. proposed Trail through Time.

45. **Appraisal Event:** Mrs. Rosenau updated the Commission on preparations for the "Treasure or
46. Trash" appraisal event. The event will be held on Tuesday, 10 May 2022 from 6:30pm to 9:30pm in
47. Town Hall.

48. Mrs. Gaudreau will create advertising posters for the event to be displayed at local
49. businesses and on the Heritage Commission Facebook page.

50. Mrs. Gaudreau informed the Commission she will invite the Sandown Historical Society
51. to the event to display some historically significant items and perhaps have them appraised for the
52. fun of it and commentary.

55. **Barn Event:** Mrs. Rosenau updated the Commission on preparations for the “The History of

58. Mrs. Rosenau made a motion to expend up to \$30 for refreshments for the event. Motion was
59. seconded by Mr. Wentzel. So voted by the Commission.

61. **Town History Book:** Mrs. Gaudreau informed the Commission that another 20 copies of “The
62. View from Meetinghouse Hill” have been ordered for a cost of \$370.99. The Commission is awaiting
63. delivery.

65. **Other Business:** Mrs. Gaudreau reminded the viewing audience on Sandown Cable 17 that the Old
66. Meetinghouse would be hosting an Open House on Sunday, 1 May 2022 between 1:00pm and
67. 4:00pm. Ben Winter, whose Eagle Scout Project is to expand the Food Pantry, will be holding a talk
68. On the history of Sandown’s Meetinghouse and fundraising for his project.

70. Mrs. Rosenau reminded the Commission that she will be hosting a Heritage Commission Yard Sale in
71. the driveway of 159 Little Mill Rd on Saturday, 23 April between 9:00am and 2:00pm.

73. Mrs. Gaudreau proposed organizing a Stone Structure Site Walk for anyone interested in participating
74. on a date to be determined, likely in June or July.

76. The Commission Members set the date and time for the next Heritage Commission meeting for
