34	Beer Mugs and Openers:
35	Ms. Olsen and Mrs. Gulla shared that there are about 30 openers left and
36	about 90 mugs left. The Committee discussed ordering additional openers
37	but decided not to. Ms. Olsen added that she will be delivering some mugs
38	this weekend and again added that there a few people that placed orders and

haven't paid, so she was planning to reach out to them to confirm their orderand request payment.

43 Mrs. Jortberg shared that she has sent the music schedule to Mark Gordon

- 104 cancelling the reservation for the high strikers.

107 Ms. Olsen shared that she had contacted a screen printing company in

- 108 Windham that would print shirts for \$13.00 per shirt. She noted that there
- 109 was a slight increase in price for plus size shirts. The Committee discussed
- 110 different options for shirts, and decided to not pursue the shirt company.
- 111 Mrs. Jortberg said that she was willing to get the shirts made for us as she is
- 112 having her daughter make some for the Two-to-Lou beer tent crew. The
- 113 committee decided to personally reimburse Mrs. Jortberg for the price of the
- shirts rather than using the committee funds.
