53 forwarded to the Recreation Director and members of the Recreation Commission.

57 Anthony reported that it would cost \$800 for Pat the Patriot to come to the event for 2
58 hours and it would cost \$600 per cheerleader for a two hour period. The expense is too
59 great to consider this option.

80 enactment demonstration and to march in the parade

84 The Boy Scouts will march in the parade and carry the parade banner.
