

Public Consumption of Alcohol Town Ordinance

At the 1980 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #32 was voted on:

31. To see if the voters of the Town of Sandown will vote to adopt the provisions of this Ordinance in accordance with RSA 31:39, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to use or consume any alcoholic beverage while in or upon the following:

1. Any public way as defined in RSA 259:1 (XXXV), park, playground or any way or place in which the public has a right of access as invitees or licensees, except with a permit issued by the Board of Selectmen.
2. Any private land, building, structure or place without the consent of the owner or person in control thereof.

Any person convicted under this ordinance shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) for each offense, which sum shall inure to the benefit of the Town of Sandown General Fund.

This ordinance to take effect immediately upon passage.

Article #29 was passed by a voice vote:
