

Mutual Aid Town Ordinance

In the 1990 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #35 was voted on by the townspeople:

YES
ARTICLE 35. TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL VOTE TO ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING AS A TOWN ORDINANCE: THE VOTERS OF SANDOWN, HEREBY, AUTHORIZE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE RSA 106-C:3, THE CHIEF OF THE SANDOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT TO EXTEND ASSISTANCE IN TIME OF EMERGENCY TO ANY OTHER MUNICIPALITY OR THE COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM SUBJECT TO SUCH RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS AS MAY BE IMPOSED BY LAW.

The article passed on a voice vote:

ARTICLE #35 MUTUAL AID. A MOTION BY LEO BEAUCHAMP, SECONDED, TO ACCEPT AS READ WAS WAS PASSED ON A VOICE VOTE AFTER A SHORT DISCUSSION ON THE MERITS OF THE PROPOSAL. APPROVED.

The ordinance now reads:

“The voters of Sandown, hereby, authorize pursuant to the provisions of New Hampshire RSA 106-C:3, the Chief of the Sandown Police Department to extend assistance in the time of emergency to any other municipality or the County of Rockingham subject to such restrictions and conditions as may be imposed by law”.
