

Occupancy Permit Town Ordinance

In the 1990 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #40 was voted on by the townspeople:

YES

ARTICLE 40. TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL VOTE TO ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING AS A TOWN ORDINANCE: IF A BUILDING IS OCCUPIED BEFORE THE OCCUPANCY PERMIT IS SIGNED OFF AND ISSUED BY THE BUILDING INSPECTOR, A \$50.00 PER DAY FINE WILL BE LEVIED TO THE OWNER OF RECORD AS PER THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION.

The article was passed on a voice vote:

ARTICLE #40 TOWN ORDINANCE. OCCUPANCY PERMIT. A MOTION BY JOSEPH MICHELIN, SECONDED, TO ACCEPT AS READ WAS PASSED ON A VOICE VOTE. APPROVED.

The ordinance now reads:

“If a building is occupied before the occupancy permit is signed off and issued by the building inspector, a \$50.00 per day fine will be levied to the owner of record as per the registry of deeds at the time of the violation”.
