Snow Removal Town Ordinance

In the 1990 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #41 was voted on by the townspeople:

ARTICLE 41. TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL VOTE TO ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING AS A TOWN ORDINANCE: IT SHALL BE A VIOLATION TO CAUSE SNOW TO BE PLOWED FROM A DRIVEWAY OR WALKWAY INTO A TOWN ACCEPTED OR TOWN MAINTAINED ROAD. SAID VIOLATION SHALL CARRY WITH IT A FINE OF \$100.00 TO BE ASSESSED TO THE PROPERTY OWNER.

The article was modified and passed on a voice vote:

ARTICLE #41 TOWN ORDINANCE. SNOW PLOWING. A MOTION TO AMEND BY CARROLL BASSETT, SECONDED, TO ADD THE WORDS "SHOVELED OR BLOWN" AFTER THE WORD "PLOWED" IN LINE TWO OF THE ORIGINAL ARTICLE WAS PASSED ON A VOICE VOTE. A PROPOSAL TO MAKE THE FINE CHARGEABLE TO THE PLOW OPERATOR INSTEAD OF THE PROPERTY OWNER FAILED TO BE APPROVED. A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE AMENDED ARTICLE BY WILLIAM CRUM, SECONDED, PASSED ON A VOICE VOTE. AMENDED ARTICLE APPROVED.

The ordinance now reads:

"It shall be a violation to cause snow to be plowed, shoveled or blown from a driveway or walkway into a Town accepted or Town maintained road. Said violation shall carry with it a fine of \$100.00 to be assessed to the property owner".
