

Stock At Large Town Ordinance

At the 1998 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #20 was voted and passed by the townspeople:

ARTICLE 20. SHALL THE TOWN VOTE TO ENACT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE: STOCK AT LARGE - TO PROHIBIT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF HORSES, CATTLE, SHEEP, SWINE, GEESE, GOATS AND OTHER POULTRY AND ANIMALS PURSUANT TO RSA 47:17X. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$50.00 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE AND \$100.00 FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES. (Recommended by Board of Selectmen)			YES	598

The Town Ordinance reads:

“Stock At Large – To prohibit the running at large of horses, cattle, sheep, swine, geese, goats and other poultry and animals pursuant to RSA 47:17X, violators may be subject to a fine of up to \$50.00 for the first offense and \$100.00 for any subsequent offenses”.

As of 2013, this Town Ordinance was found to be not in compliance with State Law and is no longer valid as written.
