

Seeley Beach & Park Town Ordinance

In the 1986 Town Meeting, Warrant Article #40 enacted the enforcement of the Seeley Park Ordinance, which passed on a voice vote:

ARTICLE 40. Enforcement of Seeley Park ordinance. Motion by Arthur Fay, seconded, to accept article as read. Much discussion concerning Life Guard. Recommended to Recreation Comm. to hire a Life Guard and use money in budget. Motion by Lee Wilmot to move the question, seconded. Passed on voice vote. PASSED

In 2003, this ordinance was updated with Warrant Article #23:

23. Warrant Article. To see if the town will vote to adopt the following for an ordinance: Anyone not adhering to the rules and regulations of Seeley Beach and Park will be fined \$100.00. The rules and regulations are as follows: no unauthorized vehicles, glass containers, alcoholic beverages, animals at any time or fires. Children under 12 unless accompanied by an adult. Swim at your own risk when lifeguard is not on duty. The beach is closed from dusk to dawn. This ordinance will supercede any existing warrant articles in regard to this property. Recommended by the Board of Selectmen.

This warrant article now reads:

“Anyone not adhering to the rules and regulations of Seeley Beach and Park will be fined \$100.00. The rules and regulations are as follows:

- ***No unauthorized vehicles***
- ***No glass containers***
- ***No alcoholic beverages***
- ***No animals at any time***
- ***No fires***
- ***No children under 12 unless accompanied by an adult***
- ***Swim at your own risk when lifeguard is not on duty***
- ***The Beach is closed from Dusk to Dawn”***
