SELECTMEN'S ORDINANCE

Seeley Beach Rules

Seeley Beach is open to <u>Sandown Residents and Accompanied Guests Only</u> and is open from Dawn to Dusk. <u>Residents must obtain a seasonal pass</u>.

- 1. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK WHEN NO LIFEGUARD IS PRESENT.
- 2. No children under the age of 12 without adult supervision.
- 3. No unauthorized vehicles of any kind including ATV/OHRV/Snowmobiles. Do not park near the emergency access gate off North Shore Road. Visitors may park in Library parking lot.
- 4. No glass containers. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- 5. No smoking on the beach or in the water. Smoke only in the grassy area distancing yourself from others. Please dispose of your cigarette properly once extinguished. Do NOT leave in sand!
- 6. No animals of any type.
- 7. No fires.
- 8. No abusive or vulgar language permitted.
- 9. No fighting of any type whether verbal or physical including rough horseplay.
- 10. This is a Carry-In/Carry-Out facility. Take your trash with you when you leave.
- 11. It is prohibited to feed waterfowl at any time. Do NOT fish in swim area.
- 12. Babies and Toddlers are not allowed to be naked on the beach or in the water. You will be instructed to place a diaper on your child. Swim diapers are preferred.
- 13. Leave the water immediately upon direction of lifeguards.

EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT AND PHONE AVAILABLE ONLY WHEN LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. For nearest emergency phone exit the beach north onto Main Street (Route 121A) travel approximately 500 feet to the Fire Department or Town Hall. There is also a landline in the library located across the street from the park. These phones are only available during regular business hours of these locations.

BEACH IS LOCATED AT 306 MAIN STREET.

Lifeguards are authorized to carry out all rules and regulations of this park. Police will be contacted if you fail to follow the direction or request of lifeguards. Anyone not adhering to these rules and regulations will be ejected from the beach and/or fined \$100. Appropriate police action may be taken.

This ordinance will supersede any existing warrant articles or ordinances regarding this property and will be effective July 17, 2020. Violators of this Selectmen's Ordinance will be subject to a \$100 fine.
