Counselors

Lynne said she has received no applications for counselors, and is concerned that the pay is too low. Counselors are currently paid \$9 per hour, with surrounding towns offering higher pay for counselors. (Atkinson is paying \$11 per hour and Plaistow is paying \$12 per hour.) Dyer mentioned offering referral bonus as incentive to get counselors, and suggested staff perks such as Free Pizza Friday. Lynne said so far they have 7 returning counselors out of the 18 they had last year. Thompson suggested marketing the position to high school seniors who are entering college for Early Childhood Education. Members discussed budget regarding Summer Rec Program, and agreed to make online post to advertise counselor positions on Sandown Rec Facebook page and share to every community page in the district.
