

Phillips Pond Abutter,

The Town of Sandown has contracted SŌLitude Lake



Management, 590 Lake Street, Shrewsbury, MA 01545, Telephone 866-480-1271, to treat portions of Phillips Pond in Sandown with USEPA/State registered herbicides Procellacor EC (Florpyrauxifen-benzyl liquid), EPA Reg. No. 67690-80 and Flumigard SC (flumioxazin), EPA Reg. No. 81927-78, to control exotic variable milfoil and fanwort weeds.

A permit application has been filed with the state requesting approval for this treatment program. The treatments will likely be performed in early June (milfoil) and mid-July (fanwort) 2023. If a permit is issued, there will be additional notifications of the actual treatment areas, dates and specific information on certain activities and water uses that will be temporarily restricted as a condition of the permit. Any questions concerning the proposed treatment should be directed to SŌLitude Lake Management at the above address.

Those wishing to comment on the proposed application may contact the New Hampshire Department of Agriculture, Division of Pesticide Control to request a public hearing. Comments must be received in writing within 15 days of receipt of this notice.

The treatment is tentatively scheduled for early June to mid-July 2023. Based on past experiences, we expect that the State will impose <u>restrictions</u> on the use of treated pond water for <u>irrigation</u> purposes. The specific use restrictions will be determined at the time the permit is issued and will be communicated directly to you in the notification of treatment that will be sent by certified-mail.

The restrictions extend to direct water intakes located within 200 feet of the treatment areas and to wells within 50 feet of the treatment areas. Intakes (black pipe) that draw water directly from Phillips Pond, within 200 feet of proposed treatment areas, WILL be subject to irrigation restrictions.
